Top questions to ask when admitted to the NICU

Understanding Your Baby's Condition

- 1. Why was my baby admitted to the NICU?
- 2. What is my baby's current condition?
- 3. What are the main concerns or risks for my baby at this time?
- 4. Are there any immediate treatments or interventions that my baby needs?

Care and Treatment Plan

- 1. What is the treatment plan for my baby?
- 2. What medications or treatments will my baby receive and what are they for?
- 3. How often will my baby be monitored and what is being monitored?
- 4. How long do you expect my baby to stay in the NICU?

Understanding the NICU Environment

- 1. Can you explain the equipment and monitors being used for my baby?
- 2. Can you explain what the different alarms and sounds mean?

Feeding and Nutrition

- 1. How will my baby be fed? (e.g. breastfeeding, bottle, tube or another way)
- 2. What will my baby be fed? (e.g. breast milk, donor milk, or formula)
- 3. Will my milk or my baby's feedings need to be fortified?? If so, what type of fortifier will be used? Are there other types of fortifiers available?
- 4. Can I provide breast milk or be involved in feeding my baby?
- 5. How is my baby's nutrition being monitored?

Parental Involvement

- 1. How can I participate in my baby's care?
- 2. How can I contact the NICU staff if I have questions or concerns?
- 3. Will there be regular meetings held to discuss my baby's progress with the care team?

Potential Complications and Outcomes

1. What complications or outcomes should I be aware of?

Support for Parents and Families

- 1. What emotional and psychological support is available to parents?
- 2. How can we manage stress during this time?
- 3. Are there resources or support groups available to us?

Preparing for Discharge

- 1. What are the criteria for my baby to be discharged from the NICU?
- 2. What kind of follow-up will be needed after we are discharged?
- 3. Will we receive training on how to manage our baby at home?
- 4. What should we expect during our transition from NICU to home?
- 5. Are there any signs or symptoms that I should watch for when my baby is discharged?
